Our Top Five Information Items

- 1. Our hockey staff are full-time, certified hockey coaches and trainers** who work with your student-athlete for 10 months a year (minimum).
- 2. We operate like a 'Mini-University'**, which is the best process to acclimatize the student-athlete to education and hockey within the same learning environment.
- 3. The model of our school is: Academics, Athletics, & Character.** Our goal is to graduate top end student-athletes with leadership and character skills.
- 4. The academic performance** of our students and teachers places us in the top 20% of schools in the province. Student-athletes are challenged to achieve personal excellence in academics, and will be held to a set of individual, as well as Edge School and provincial goals.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: Our tuition is currently \$17,870 for Grades 4-6. Grades 7-12 is \$18,970. For Edge School Hockey Players, team fees in addition to tuition range between \$13,000-\$17,000 per season depending on the team.

Q: Is there financial assistance?

A: An independent school education requires a major financial commitment. In response, Edge School has established a Student Awards Program to recognize and assist qualified students. We offer both merit and need-based awards for our families. Q: Is there billeting available? Dorms?

A: There are no dorms or residences and we do not have a billeting program. Having said that, we have several players from out of town and through the Edge community we may be able to connect students with potential billets.

Q: Is there busing?

A: Busing is available at an additional cost. There are specific pick-up and drop-off points that are adjusted yearly depending on student enrollment. Our three busing routes begin in Okotoks, Chestermere and Airdrie, and from there serve all quadrants of Calgary.

Q: What does a school day/semester look like?

A: The school year is comprised of four terms within two semesters. Here is a day in the life at Edge:
