U15 Team Wins First CSSHL Championship



Congratulations to our U15 hockey team for capturing their first ever CSSHL Championship!

It was the first time in CSSHL history that a team from outside the Lower Mainland in British Columbia won the league's U15 Western Canadian championship.

The team went on a Cinderella-esque run, beating the regular season division champion Burnaby Lions 4-3 in a shootout to advance to the finals. In the gold-medal game, they bested second place Yale 6-5 to capture the victory.

Head Coach, Micki DuPont, says being cheered on by the other Edge teams in attendance for playoffs provided the U15s with the added motivation they needed. "I think it really pushed us over the top and gave us some extra energy to win the championship. It was such a cool feeling and that's a neat part of the school as well – the culture of the kids cheering for each other and pushing each other on is great to see."

The playoffs were a big success for all of our teams this year, with U18 and U16 Prep making it all the way to their respective finals as well. Although both teams lost in their final games of the season, it was great to see all of our Mountaineers come together to cheer each other on, and create an unreal atmosphere during our Edge games. U18 Female Prep (quarter-finals), U17 Prep (quarter-finals) and U15 Prep (semifinals) came up short, but all showed great class and sportsmanship along the way.


The Alberta Junior Hockey League has been announcing award winners for the 2021-22 season, and three Mountaineers were recognized:
