





























### **Celebrating Post-Secondary Athletic Achievements**


It has been a very proud few weeks to be an Edge Mountaineer as we watched six alumni win National Championships with their respective university programs!


The MRU Cougars <u>won their first ever Women's Hockey National U SPORTS</u>
