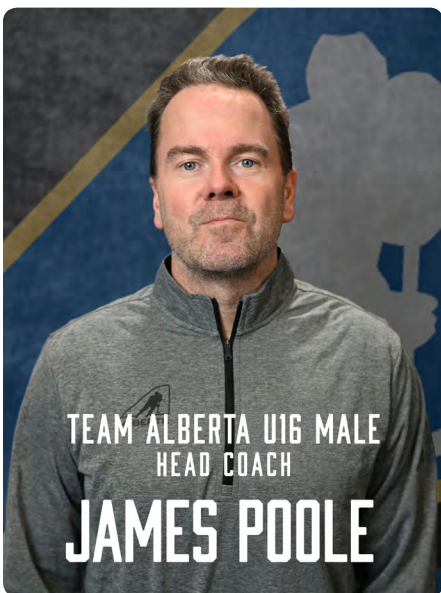
Beuk Sisters Compete in BTB Soccer Tournament
