

Seven Mountaineers Represent Their Country















It's been an exciting summer seeing Mountaineers past and present representing their country at various international events:

• Bubu Benjamin (Team Canada, FIBA U19 Men's Basketball World Cup)

Canada went 3-4 in the tournament and finished in seventh place. Bubu averaged 9.1 points, 4.3 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.6 steals (team high) per game.

• Yvonne Ejim (Team Canada Senior National Team, FIBA Women's AmeriCup – Third Place)

Yvonne averaged 7.9 points and 4.3 rebounds per game, helping lead Team Canada to a bronze medal.

• Charlie Elick (Team Canada U18, 2023 Hlinka Gretzky Cup – First Place)

Team Canada went 2-1 in the preliminary round before beating the United States in the semifinals. In the final, Canada pulled off a 3-2 victory in an overtime thriller against Czechia to take home the gold medal.

Eirny Erinugha and Jayda Queeley (Team Canada, FIBA U16 Women's Americas Championship – Second Place)

Team Canada made it all the way to the gold medal game, but fell 77-49 to a tough United States team. Regardless of the outcome, it was a great experience for both Mountaineers as they come back to Calgary with a silver medal.

• Tyler Myers (Team Canada, IIHF World Hockey Championship – First Place)

This was the fifth time Tyler represented Team Canada on the world stage, and first time since the 2014 World Championships as he helped the Canadian team to a gold medal.

Xavier Spencer (Antiqua & Barbuda Men's National Basketball Team, 2025 FIBA Americup Qualifiers)

X averaged 6.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 1.0 steal per game and made a big impression with the Antigua & Barbuda Men's Basketball Team.



Congratulations to all of you for working so hard to set yourselves up for this next step in your academic and athletic journeys. We wish you all the best!















Kipkie Selected in NHL Draft

Class of 2023 grad Justin Kipkie was <u>drafted by the Arizona Coyotes in the 2023 NHL Draft</u> (5th round, 32nd pick)! Kips spent three seasons playing on Edge teams and suited up in 67 CSSHL games for Edge, compiling 56 points. In 2021-22, he was nominated for the CSSHL U18 Prep defenceman of the year after putting up 29 points (9 G, 20 A) in 32 games.

Justin excelled both on the ice and in the classroom for Victoria in the WHL this year, earning top marks and tallying 33 points (eight goals, 25 assists) in 67 games played, which ranked second amongst all Royals blue liners. The season earned him a pair of Royals' team awards, being named the Jo-Ann Thompson Foundation Scholastic Player of the Year and the team's Rookie of the Year. In June, he was presented with the Edge Athletic Achievement Award, awarded to the graduating student who has earned extraordinary athletic accomplishments during their time at the school.





Four Graduates Commit to Jr. A Teams





Congratulations to these four class of 2023 student-athletes that signed contracts to play junior hockey next season:

Jeremy Ahn signed with the Camrose Kodiaks (AJHL). Jeremy was a Mountaineer since 2018-19 and suited up for each of our five men's teams along the way – playing in 120 games. Last season with U17 Prep, he scored 74 points in 31 games (19 G, 55 A) as he led the team in scoring. In an injury shortened year with U18 Prep this season, Jeremy averaged over a point per game with 20 points in 18 CSSHL regular season and playoff games.

Ashton Gallagher signed with the Calgary Canucks (AJHL). Gally was a Mountaineer since 2018-19 and suited up for each of our five men's teams along the way – playing in 144 CSSHL games. His best statistical year came with the U17 Prep squad last season when he scored 34 goals and added 34 assists.





Jett Koch has signed with the Calgary Canucks. Jett played in 83 CSSHL games for Edge, and had his most notable statistical season with U17 Prep last year when he had 52 points in 32 games (20 G, 32 A). That particular season earned him a Most Valuable Mountaineer team award, recognition on the CSSHL's All-Academic team, and Edge School's male fitness award. Jett was also the class of 2023 Valedictorian, and received the Governor General's Bronze Medal which is awarded annually to the graduating student who has achieved the highest overall academic average in the Grade 12 class.

Luke McCrady signed with the Niverville Nighthawks (MJHL). Luke played in his 99th game (regular season and playoffs) as a Mountaineer in the CSSHL U18 Prep Championship Final – capping off his Edge career with a playoff title. In those 99 games in an Edge uniform, Luke compiled 37 points.

Courchesne Wins Gold at AB Summer Games





Sanderson an NHL All-Rookie


Congratulations to former Mountaineer, Jake Sanderson, on being named to the NHL's All-Rookie Team for 2022/23.

Sanderson, the fifth overall selection from the 2020 NHL Draft, ranked second among rookie defensemen with 32 points (4 G, 28 A) in 77 appearances. His 28 assists and 32 points both were the third-most in Senators history by a rookie blue liner. Sanderson also placed among the leading 2022-23 rookies, forwards and defensemen, in total time on ice (2nd; 1,687:52), average time on ice (2nd; 21:55), power-play assists (2nd; 15), power-play points (2nd; 17), assists (4th; 28) and shots on goal (5th; 132).




Nielsen Signs NHL Contract

Class of 2018 graduate Tristen Nielsen signed an NHL entry-level contract with the Vancouver Canucks. Tristen played 175 games in an Edge uniform, compiling a whopping 221 points. Since his time here, he went on to play five seasons in the WHL with the Calgary Hitmen and Vancouver Giants before spending the last two seasons with the Abbotsford Canucks in the AHL. Justin Stathopoulos has committed to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas and the their hockey program in the ACHA. Stath appeared in 133 games (regular season and playoffs) for Edge teams from 2015-2019. 
