


#### Three Former Mountaineers Make Team Canada Rosters



- was runner-up for Hockey East Rookie of the Year.





Congratulations to these four former Mountaineers who have made the step in each of their hockey careers:

 Class of 2023 graduate, Gabe Bergeron, has signed with the Sicamous Eagles in the KIJHL! Gabe played on our two U17 teams the past two seasons, compiling a 23-7-2 record, .912 save percentage, and a 2.79 goals against average across 34 CSSHL regular season appearances.

In 2021-22, Gabe's .921 SV% was tops among all U17 Prep CSSHL goaltenders, and his 14 wins was second most in the division.

Class of 2023 graduate, Brendan Calahasen, has signed with the Nelson Leafs in the KIJHL!

Brendan was a Mountaineer for four years, suiting up for the U17 Prep team for three seasons before making the U18 team this past year. In total, he played in 102 regular season and playoff games, with his best statistical season coming in 2021-22 when he scored 30 goals and had 48 points in 33 games.

Connor Gourley has committed to Arizona State University in the NCAA.

Connor played on our U18 Prep team in 2019-20, compiling 39 points (20 G, 19 A) in 26 games. He has spent the past four seasons playing in the AJHL – splitting time with the Camrose Kodiaks and most recently with the Okotoks Oilers.

 Class of 2020 graduate, Sam McGinley, has committed to play post-secondary hockey at the University of New Brunswick for the 2023/24 season.

Sam has been playing in the WHL since 2019-20 when he started out with the Regina Pats, playing in 11 total games before being traded to the Swift Current Broncos. The defenceman would go on to play 184 games for the Broncos. He scored 20 goals and added 56 assists for 76 points in his Bronco career that spanned over parts of four seasons. His career best came in the 2022/2023 season when he tallied 37 points in 61 games with the Broncos.

Sam spent two seasons at Edge School, playing for the Elite 15 team and the U18 Prep team. He played in 72 CSSHL games in an Edge uniform, compiling 75 points (19 G, 56 A).
