January Senior Exams

The January Senior Exam Schedule has been posted on our website and <u>can be found here</u>. Please note that only Grades 10-12 will have a formal exam schedule during this period.

During Exam time (Jan. 22-30) there are **no classes for Grade 10-12 students**. They only need to attend during their scheduled exams. Buses will still be running at regular times during that week and the cafeteria will remain open.

Exam Reminders for Students:

- Get a good night sleep the night before the exam
- Make sure you have a healthy, balanced breakfast
- Please ensure that you arrive at least 15 minutes before the start time
- Ensure you are wearing Edgewear
- No digital devices will be allowed in the exam rooms
- Leave your backpack in your locker or vehicle
- Food and snacks are allowed in clear containers or bags



- Bring extra writing utensils (pencils, pens, etc)
- Bring a graphing calculator or scientific calculator for necessary subjects
- All graphing calculators will be cleared of memory upon arrival and after the exam
- Exam locations will be posted in the foyer and throughout the school

Junior Focus Week

During Senior Exam week, we try to plan something special for our juniors (Grades 4-9). Last year, if you recall, we engaged in a digital storytelling week where the students made short films. This year we are choosing to focus on digital safety and bullying awareness. We have engaged a member of the Calgary Police Service (online safety) as well as the <u>Dare to Care</u> (anti-bullying) program to work with our staff and students. Students will also be creating their own posters/videos to summarize their learning and to showcase around the school.

We are very excited to provide this opportunity for our students, in conjunction with our Parent Council. These presentations and the interactive work will take place in the afternoons of the week of January 22-26. **During this time, Grade 4-7 sport block will shift from the afternoon to the morning**. Regular classes will take place the remainder of the time. The specific schedule will be shared by your child's junior teachers in the coming days.

Re-enrolment Information

We have launched our re-enrollment for the 2024-25 school year. **As an existing family, your placement priority is guaranteed until Monday January 15, 2024**. After that date, we will offer available spaces to eligible new and existing families on a first come, first served basis. As in previous years, we will limit class sizes. It is important to note that, in several grades, we already have waiting lists and have limited spaces available in other grades.
