The January Senior Exam Schedule has been posted on our website and <u>can be found here</u>. Please note that only Grades 10-12 will have a formal exam schedule during this period.

During Exam time (Jan. 22-30) there are **no classes for Grade 10-12 students**. They only need to attend during their scheduled exams. Buses will still be running at regular times during that week and the cafeteria will remain open.

Exam Reminders for Students:

- Get a good night sleep the night before the exam
- Make sure you have a healthy, balanced breakfast
- Please ensure that you arrive at least 15 minutes before the start time
- Ensure you are **wearing Edgewear**
- No digital devices will be allowed in the exam rooms
- Leave your backpack in your locker or vehicle
- Food and snacks are allowed in clear containers or bags
- Make sure to hydrate
- Bring extra writing utensils (pencils, pens, etc)
- Bring a graphing calculator or scientific calculator for necessary subjects
- All graphing calculators will be cleared of memory upon arrival and after the exam
- Exam locations will be posted in the foyer and throughout the school
