Three Alumni Selected at NHL Draft, Parascak Signs



Congratulations to our the three former Mountaineers that were selected at this year's National Hockey League Entry Draft!

Terik Parascak (1st Round, 17th Overall) - Washington Capitals

A class of 2024 grad, Terik played for four Edge teams (U15, U15 Prep, U16 Prep and U18 Prep) and will go down as one of the best players to suit up for our hockey program. In 116 CSSHL regular season and playoff games, he tallied an astounding 133 goals and 109 assists for 242 points. In his rookie season with the Prince George Cougars this year, Terik took the WHL by storm. He racked up 43 goals, 62 assists, 105 points in 68 games – leading all rookies in goals and points, which earned him a finalist nomination for the WHL Rookie of the Year.

In early June, he was presented with the Edge Athletic Achievement Award, awarded to the graduating student who has earned extraordinary athletic accomplishments during their time at the school.

On July 10, Perry signed a three-year entry-level contract with the Washington Capitals.


Charlie Elick (2nd Round, 36th Overall) - Columbus Blue Jackets

Chuck played with on our U15 Prep and U18 Prep teams, and was a second semester student at Edge during the 2022/23 season. With the U18 Prep team in 2021/22, Elick had 29 points (10 G, 19 A) in 31 combined CSSHL games. Bringing a bruising, physical style to the Wheat Kings, Elick posted 27 points in 65 games for the Wheat Kings this season. In a 10-month span this year, he won two Gold Medals with Team Canada (Hlinka Gretzky Cup and World Juniors).

Eric Jamieson (6th Round, 177th Overall) - Calgary Flames

Jaimer played at Edge for three seasons (U15 Prep, U16 Prep, U18 Prep) – compiling 56 points (12 G, 44 A) in 69 combined CSSHL games. The shutdown defenceman had a great season with the Everett Silvertips this year with 32 points in 66 games, and a +34 rating to boot (12th among all WHL d-men).

Four Alumni Represent Canada, Two at the Olympics



It has been a very exciting summer watching Edge student-athletes (past and present) represent Canada Internationally at various events:

Patrick Anamali - Basketball

Played for Canada at the U17 World Cup in Turkey. Patrick averaged 3.4 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.7 steals per game. Canada went 3-4 in the tournament, finishing in eighth place.

Yvonne Ejim – Basketball

Yvonne is currently with Canada Basketball at the 2024 Paris Olympics. A class of 2020 grad, Yvonne is coming off of a remarkable season with the Gonzaga Bulldogs:

- 2024 Academic All-American
- 2024 Becky Hammon Player of the Year
- 2024 WCC Player of the Year
- 2024 WCC Defensive Player of the Year
- 2024 All-WCC First Team
- 6x WCC Player of the Week in 2023-24
- 2024 All-Academic WCC Team

This is Yvonne's 10th time representing Canada at an International event. Canada has only played one game thus far in Paris (a 75-54 loss to France). They play their next game tomorrow against Australia.

Piper Logan - Rugby

Piper Logan just won a silver medal with Team Canada's Women's Rugby Sevens at the 2024 Paris Olympics! Canada upset third-ranked France and second-ranked Australia to clinch Canada's best-ever Olympic Rugby result. Congratulations to Piper and Team Canada!

Piper was at Edge for her Grade 8 and 9 years (2014-2016) in the dance program before going on to Ernest Manning High School. She started rugby in 2016 and along the way has played with the Calgary Hornets, the Calgary Mavericks and the U SPORTS' UBC Thunderbirds.

Ify Nwaobi - Basketball

Won silver at the FIBA U18 Women's AmeriCup in Bucaramanga, Colombia. Canada placed atop the Group A standings with a record of 3-0, and advanced to the gold medal game after defeating Mexico in the quarter-finals and Brazil in the semi-finals. The United States beat Canada in a closely contested final at Coliseo Bicentenario on June 23. Ify averaged 6.0 points and 6.3 rebounds.










Six Mountaineers take next step in Hockey Journeys

Congratulations to these six Mountaineers who have signed contracts for the 2024/25 hockey season:



Kennedy Bobyck - HV71 (SDHL)

The class of 2019 grad signed in the Swedish Women's Hockey League! The SDHL is the elite league for women's hockey in Sweden, and HV71 plays in Jönköping, in the southern Swedish province of Småland.

Bobber played at Edge for two seasons (2017-2019) and averaged over a point-per-game with 46 points in 44 CSSHL regular season games. After graduating from Edge, Kennedy played five seasons of NCAA hockey at Minnesota State University – Mankato, compiling 73 points (24 G, 49) for the Mavericks.



Dylan Deets - Lloydminster Bobcats (AJHL)

Dylan has been at Edge for three years – playing on the U15, U15 Prep and U17 Prep Gold teams. Dylan won a CSSHL Championship with the U15 team in 2021/22, and has been an offensive force while patrolling the blueline at Edge. In 110 combined CSSHL games, Dylan has compiled 20 goals and 66 assists (86 points). This season, he was a co-captain for coach Mruk and also wore an 'A' with the U15 Prep team.



Logan Murray - Calgary Canucks (AJHL)

Murr has been at Edge for three years, playing on our U15 Prep, U17 Prep and U18 Prep teams. He has been a steady offensive presence on each team he's played on, compiling 117 points (46 G, 71 A) in 102 CSSHL games (regular season and playoffs).



Sawyer Samycia - Fernie Ghostriders (KIJHL)

Sawyer played for the U17 Prep Maroon squad and was this year's team captain and Most Valuable Mountaineer.

He spent the last two seasons playing for Coach Miller and compiled 38 points (15 G, 23 A) in 68 CSSHL games.

Maxim Shushkov - Bonnyville Pontiacs (AJHL)

The class of 2024 graad has been at Edge for two years, playing on our U18 Prep team and helping the team to back-to-back U18 Prep titles in the process. The hard hitting d-man played in 72 CSSHL regular season and playoff games, chipping in with 25 points.

Yibin Yoo - Olds Grizzlys (AJHL)

The 2023 U18 Prep champ and class of 2024 grad spent four years with our Edge teams (2019-2023) and was a second semester student this year after playing for the North Iowa Bulls in the NAHL.

Yibin appeared in 106 combined CSSHL games, tallying 99 points (44 G, 55 A).

Smith makes Team Canada U18 Roster, Three others attend U17 Development Camp



Congrats to former U18 Prep Mountaineer and current Tri-City Americans defenceman, Jackson Smith, on being named to Canada's 2024 Hlinka Gretzky Cup Team Roster. This is the second time Jackson will represent Team Canada. He was on Team Canada Red's roster for the 2023 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge.

In his first full season with Tri-City this year, Smitty had 29 points (8 G, 21 A) in 61 games. He caught fire in the second half of the season with 23 of his 29 points coming over the last 36 games of the 2023-24 season. At season's end, Smitty was named the Americans team Rookie of the Year.

Ryley Budd

Buddzy had an exceptional year with the U18 Prep this season finishing with a 1.77 GAA and a .936 SV% in 17 games. Ryley finished the season with a 15-2-0 record in the regular season and capped it off with a championship as Edge School captured the CSSHL U18 Prep Western Championship. His season was capped off by him being named to the CSSHL 1st All-Star Team, and as the top goaltender in the U18 division.

Landon DuPont


Dups notched 19 goals and 43 assists for 62 points in 30 regular season games with U18 Prep, leading the team in scoring and finishing third in scoring overall in the CSSHL U18 division.


In the post-season, he added 16 points (5 G, 11 A) in five games and tied the U18 Prep record for most points in a U18 playoffs. The U18 Prep champ was named the U18 Prep top defenceman at season's end.

Cruz Pavao

Cruz is preparing for his first full season in the WHL after being drafted by the Americans 13th overall in the 2023 WHL Prospects Draft. With the U18 Prep team last season, Cruz played 27 regular season games and recorded 39 points (16-23-39). During the CSSHL Championships, Cruz added another 11 points (3-8-11) in just five games, including assisting on the overtime-winning goal in the U18 championship game.

He also made quite the first impression on the Tri-City Americans and the WHL by scoring five goals in eight games as an affiliate call up during the 2023-24 season, including scoring the game-winning goal in each of his first two games.

Seven WHL Draft Selections Sign






Female B-Ball Joins NPA
