What is myPass? myPass is an Alberta Education self-service website for students to: Access their Detailed Academic Report (all HS courses completed and currently enrolled in), Order high school transcripts, View diploma exam marks and Register to write or rewrite diploma exams with online payment.

If your child is a Grade 10-12 student and they do not have access to their myPass account, please have them fill out this form and activation instructions will be sent to them.

- New Edge School sign above the main entrance


# **Edge Legacy Dinner**

- Certificate of Completion: Earn a prestigious certificate from the Harvard College Union Society, strengthening your college applications.


