As previously noted, we are entering the time of the year when we see a rise in the number of illnesses. We wanted to pass on a few basic reminders regarding prevention and expectations:

 If you are feeling ill, stay home. Please practice good hand hygiene and cover your mouth with a tissue or sneeze/cough into your arm. Please avoid sharing water bottles with other students.

We have two reported cases of hand, foot and mouth disease in the school and wanted to pass on some specific information about this illness, which are very similar to other respiratory and gastrointestinal illnesses and can be found <u>here</u>.

To ensure that we highlight our student-athletes accordingly, please do not hesitate to share stories and pictures with Landon when you can.




