

WELCOME TO THE 2025-26 EDGE SCHOOL GOLF TEAM PROGRAM!

As we start our 5th official year of the program, we are setting the stage for our student athletes to have opportunities to thrive by providing all the infrastructure for success and truly create a "no excuse environment!". As the golf program evolves this year, we are developing it into the 3 team model of College-Prep & Travel team, Varsity Team and Junior Team and have worked ahead on creating some great opportunities for all ages and abilities.

This year we are introducing multiple new options and plans to give our players access to events and opportunities that are truly unique and great for building their competitive player experience resumes. Everything has been designed for players to learn tournament play and replicate college level golf team programs. It is meant to push players to realize what it actually takes to make it to the next level and learn how to be a good student athlete both on and off the golf course.

As we all know, the summer seasons are hectic and the golf season which truly begins in April for most and goes all the way through November is a long-haul for players to endure. One of the key things about our program is teaching players how to maintain their game and bodies during the season while getting them ready to compete. We have introduced the Titleist Performance Institute (TPI) programming into the program and player should be taking full advantage of the app throughout the year. In the demanding sport of competitive golf and even for those that are in the learning stages, we believe the structure that our program provides is second-to-none in terms of bringing out the best in all our student athletes.

This year we are very excited about welcoming new faces to the program that adds an abundance of talent. We are also adding some younger and developing players to the program through our Junior Development Team Program. The amount of talent in the pipeline coming through the younger grades is very impressive! We want to welcome players who now get to experience being part of a competitive team environment.

There will be some changes in the general programming schedule compared to last year so please refer to that separate document that will be available off the school website page at all times. The schedule is always subject to changes and we will strive to communicate any changes on the fly and ASAP to both player and parents chat groups using **whatsapp** this year. FALL & SPRING School season 2025/26 - *Included with Edge School Golf Team Programs fee for 2025-26 Program for grades 8 and up and optional (\$500+gst upgrade) for grades 7 and below:

FALL SEMESTER 2025 Sun Sept 1, 2025 - Oct 15, 2025 (or course closure date) & SPRING SEMESTER 2026 April 12, 2026 (estimated or course open date) - Fri June 13, 2025 (Approx 14 weeks based on seasonal weather and course availability)

Full Junior Membership privileges as designed by Mickelson National Golf Club management includes (as available):

- Access to all practices MNGC facilities. This junior membership program is <u>only</u> for Mickelson National Golf Club and does <u>not</u> extend to other Windmill Group properties.
- Golf course access as defined by junior membership rules, i.e. no Sat/Sun booking before 2pm



- Clubhouse & locker room access
- Personal member charging account privileges (with personal credit card on file set-up)
- Club storage service available on-site
- Edge Program Team players enrolled for fall 2024-25 have the option to continue membership from June 14 until the end of August 31. They must apply for the MNGC sponsored Junior program to join for the summer months to get the junior playing on course privileges and pay the difference for this time gap at \$400 plus GST. paid directly to MNGC.
- All players must fill out a registration form for all contact information. Edge Dir. of Golf and MNGC Head Professional will manage and maintain this list.
- Edge Team program players enrolled for fall 2025-26 retain outdoor practice facility access during the summer period (approx June 15 Aug 30 annually) as available.
- LaunchPad facilities are **not** included in the membership.
- Edge players must wear their Edge School Golf program apparel at all times while on-site so that they can be identified by MNGC staff.
- Players must identify and check-in with Pro Shop at all times while on-site
- Edge players are not eligible for the Mickelson National junior club championship event unless they successfully apply in the standard Mickelson Academy Sponsored Junior program.
- Edge program coaching staff to be extended the same benefits/privileges as players.
- Edge players can elect to participate in various Mickelson Academy programs during the summer season if desired to but are mandated to represent the Edge program at competitions as part of the program. There is a general understanding that players are not to be approached or enticed to join other programs without previously discussing it amongst all coaching staffs involved.
- Players are expected to be good examples of etiquette and general behaviour at all times. Incidents
 of significance will be dealt with immediately by both school and/or course staff and can potentially
 lead to loss of privileges without refund.
- A mandatory players and coaches meeting to be held annually prior to program (spring and fall) starting hosted by Miles Mortensen & Ryan Cater to review and go over all rules, regulations, policies and expectations.

THE SEPTEMBER BACK-TO-SCHOOL PLAN...

September through Oct 15 (Thanksgiving) schedule and plans:

The basic structure of the program in-season times will be:

- Senior sports block (Grades 10-12) 8:15am 10:15am
- Intermediate sports block (Grades 8-9) 10:15am -12:15pm
- Junior sports block, 1:15 3:15 pm
- Golf Team practices Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays 3:30pm 5pm., as scheduled
- Fitness training Monday's Yoga or other activities 3:40pm 4:45pm as scheduled
- No practice on Fridays after school.

Players will have the opportunity to play the Mickelson National GC (Jr. membership), Stewart Creek GC, Golden Golf Club (twice!) and our season finale for the fall season will be at Kananaskis.



All players still manage their independent schedules for tournament events that will take them all the way through mid-October before preparing to head off to one of two optional trip opportunities this fall.

Beyond the standard schedule for sports blocks this year which have some minor changes in scheduling, we have developed a very exciting fall schedule and plan. We will continue to use Mickelson National primarily as well as Springbank Links and Valley Ridge Golf Course for all practices. One of our core beliefs is that PLAYING and coaching on-course is truly the best practice. We will be elevating how much emphasis we put on course management and strategy this year in many different ways! We have all scheduled a very exciting lineup of courses we will enjoy this fall that will be released with the final schedule.

Standard Trip Policies:

Parent travel:

We enjoy having parents come on road trips. Any team parents wishing to travel alongside are always welcome but must arrange their own travel and transportation. We always recommend that parents allow players to stay, play and dine with their teammates so they get the full team travel/trip experience.

We have an expression that "learning to travel is a life skill they need to learn!".

We have high expectations for our players on the road which includes respectful personal behaviour at all times, being a good teammate to others, time management, being on time, personal & academic organization and packing properly to prepare are all things they need to learn to become competent as a student athlete. We always have fun on the road, but it takes everyone's efforts to make sure trips are great experiences.

Meals:

Please keep in mind whenever we travel on trips, the food/meals are <u>not</u> included unless otherwise stated in trip plans. There are simply far too many dietary restrictions and other complications to manage as a group. Restaurants and meals options are planned out however players pay for their own meals on all trips to allow for specific menu and personal budget considerations. Players must carry cash, debit (does not work in the USA) or a major credit card to pay for meals. We recommend a basic budget of \$50/day is a very easy budget to go by for all trips (roughly \$10 breakfast, \$15 lunch, \$25 dinner per day) for all trips, If by chance a players has a payment emergency issue on the road otherwise, coaches can cover costs with a program card and invoice back post trip directly.

USD Exchange Rate fluctuation:

All optional trips to the USA are priced out using the current USD exchange rates at the time of planning. These generally range from \$1.40 - \$1.42 USA-CDN to include all associated banking fees to account for. Due to the instability of the Canadian dollar in the past year due to unstable government relations and issues, there may occasionally be times where we must do a "cash call" to adjust costs of things in the swing more than \$0.02+. As we are always trying to work 4-12 months out on travel opportunity projects for the players, we monitor the USD exchange rate constantly versus when we have to pay out things such as deposits and final billings for things associated with the trip. We will always strive to keep parents up to date if this will come into effect due to unforeseen and uncontrollable issues.

Competitor brand logo's should not be seen or be minimized however players are not mandated to use any golf equipment.

GENERAL TEAM PROGRAM RULES, POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS OF PLAYERS:

- The Edge Golf program operates on a set annual budget based on the program fees for 2025-26 for all activities. If players are aware of any conflicts that will cause them to miss either the included Fall or Spring team 2-night trips then they must notify the Director of Golf prior to the season starting. Any scheduled golf activities (practice or on-course play) missed by players on their own accord or due to injury, unforeseen circumstances, weather or otherwise are non-refundable.
- Academics always takes priority over golf activities (athletics). All players must be in good standing academically to participate in the golf programming. Players will always be granted permission to miss golf to work on academics. Academic teachers can and will work with students to accommodate schedules but players will be required to fulfill academic work as required by teachers first. Players are always 100% responsible for making proper homework arrangements for trips and/or missed days of schools to attend events.
- All program players are expected to represent their team program in competitive events at all
 times. Use of their players' clothing package and golf bags are mandatory at all times unless
 players receive specialty equipment or apparel for specific representative events. Players
 participation points on tours such as MJT will count towards Edge Golf Academy standings
 throughout the year when/where applicable.
- Players are expected to attend all practices and game days. Daily attendance is taken and they
 must inform the coaching staff in advance if they are going to miss an activity. Missing activities
 can result in the school incurring unnecessary costs (ex. not using advanced booked stalls at
 LaunchPad) so proper notice must be given so changes can be made.
- Coaches are <u>mandated</u> to inform parents via phone, email, text, group chat and/or attendance system if players do not attend practices or any golf activity as scheduled. This is to ensure safety of all in case of school emergency such as fire alarms/drills or if the student cannot be located. Players must inform coaches if they will miss any scheduled activity as well as make their parents aware and sign in or out at the school office. We must know where you are at all times for safety.
- Mobile phone use is 100% strictly banned during all practice, gym and on-course times. Players must ask any coach available to use their phone for emergency communication with parents only. Use of phones for video recording of swings with coach permission only but there will be <u>ZERO tolerance</u> on any use of it for any social media purposes during practice times. Penalties will scale from warnings (with push-ups penalties!) to full loss of practice time if players do not respect this rule. Phones should remain in golf bags out of sight, backpacks or vans at all times otherwise. Players with medical devices that are connected to their devices are exempt from this rule for that purpose. Parents are free to call or text coaches or the school directly at any time if they need to contact their player and we shall assist during practice time.



- Players must wear proper Edge golf logo'd attire at golf facilities and adhere to general dress codes of facilities. Proper golf wear provided in player's kits includes collared polo style shirts. Players should keep golf clothes and options at school to change into. T-shirts will not be allowed at golf facilities. Sweaters and weather gear are acceptable. This also extends to proper footwear and socks. Players not wearing proper golf or athletic running style shoes will not be allowed to participate. Sandals, flip flops or anything besides proper athletic shoes will not be allowed. No denim or ripped torn style clothing is permitted and the coaching staff will have the discretion to judge if clothing is golf appropriate, or not. *Practice and dress like you play!*
- No hats or clothing brands that represent alcohol, satirical or controversial concepts. Represent your school and team program properly at all times. Anyone not respecting this rule will be not allowed to participate. All players are provided a top of the line players kit every season, there is no excuse to not have proper golf attire to wear to practice or play events. Players must wear Edge wear on all golf outings and can order extra pieces at wholesale pricing if required.
 Bottom line is simple: Dress for success, practice like you will play! Look Good → Feel Good → Play Good! Failing to plan is planning to fail!
- Behavior on all golf outings and trips is expected to be respectful at all times. Rules, timelines and school policies are to be followed and will be enforced. Good etiquette is expected at facilities and players need to conduct themselves to a high standard. There will be zero tolerance for any form of misbehavior, including, use of foul language, poor manners, inappropriate joking, taunting / bullying / teasing, excessive noise or any behavior disruptive to others around them. Any player damaging any facility property or equipment will be 100% liable for damage recovery costs and subject to possible discipline and/or suspension of privileges.
- Players are always expected to be respectful and supportive towards their teammates, classmates, coaching staff, academic teachers and all facility staff at all times. Failure to follow this general basic expectation can result in players being disallowed to participate in activities, being sent home (including during trips) or potentially being removed from the golf program and/or school entirely.

EDGE GOLF TEAM LOCKER ROOM RULES:

The Golf Team room is an exclusive **privilege** to team players. Any player not respecting the room and its contents can and will have their locker privileges and access suspended at any time. A very simple and effective zero tolerance and/or 3-strike system will be enforced. The Edge School Golf Team program is a true "College Prep" design meant to have players experience what it will be like if they achieve their goal of playing at the next level. Players should act accordingly to this at all times and develop the habits required to get there. They need to learn that they are representing themselves, the school and their coaches at all times.

NEW! All golf team members will be assigned an ACADEMIC hallway locker and should use it daily for school related items. The golf room is ONLY for your golf equipment and required sport clothing.

Players cannot be in the room without a supervising staff member at any time, no exceptions.



The room can be accessed by team players anytime with a staff member however the following basic rules apply:

- No guests/friends or other Edge students from other sport programs allowed unsupervised at any time. Non-golf team program players are <u>not allowed</u> to use any equipment including the golf simulator or clubs without the permission of Dir. of Golf Ryan Cater or senior school management.
- The Edge golf team room is under recorded high resolution and amplified audio video surveillance 24/7 on a 30-day cloud based loop.
- Any damage to any equipment or assets will be the financial responsibility of the player.
- Players may NOT use the room to study, they will use the Commons room to avoid distractions.
- No eating food in the golf team room. Players must eat lunch in the cafeteria and cannot hang out in the golf room over lunch hours. They may use the room and features during spare times to study and are allowed to practice golf shots safely in the golf room with a staff member supervising.
- Team members are 100% responsible for cleaning garbage at all times. Any spillage or mess left behind, the player(s) will receive a warning and be made to clean it immediately. Repeated issues and players can and will have their golf room privileges suspended.
- Lockers must be kept tidy at all times. No placing of excess books, clothing, food, drink bottles or equipment on the tops of the lockers at any time.
- Lockers should be locked to insure the security of things at all times, especially expensive golf
 equipment. Players must provide their own padlock for the year. The school is not responsible for
 any lost or stolen equipment or belongings.
- Absolutely no golf ball hitting or chipping in the room other than towards the simulator screen
 area when it is safe to do so. No intentional hitting of the padded roof. Proper putting practice is
 allowed as available. *Failure to follow this simple rule will result in players losing golf room
 access entirely. Teammates are expected to regulate this with each other.
- No roughhousing or horseplay otherwise of any kind at any time.
- Players will always respect the Dir. of Golf work desk area and that the golf room is also a private office space.
