Big-time recognition for two of our own.


Congratulations to Patrick Anamali and Malachi Richmond on being selected to the [All Canadian Games](#).



Sanderson Wins Olympic Gold with USA Hockey

Former Mountaineer, Jake Sanderson is an Olympic gold medalist.

The Ottawa Senators defenceman played in his second Olympics, helping the United States go 6-0 at the Milan Cortina Games to claim its third hockey gold and its first since the Miracle On Ice team won in 1980 in Lake Placid.

In six games at the Olympics, Sanderson finished with two assists. Jake also won a gold medal with Team USA at the 2021 IIHF World Junior Championships.
