Mental Health and Tech Webinar

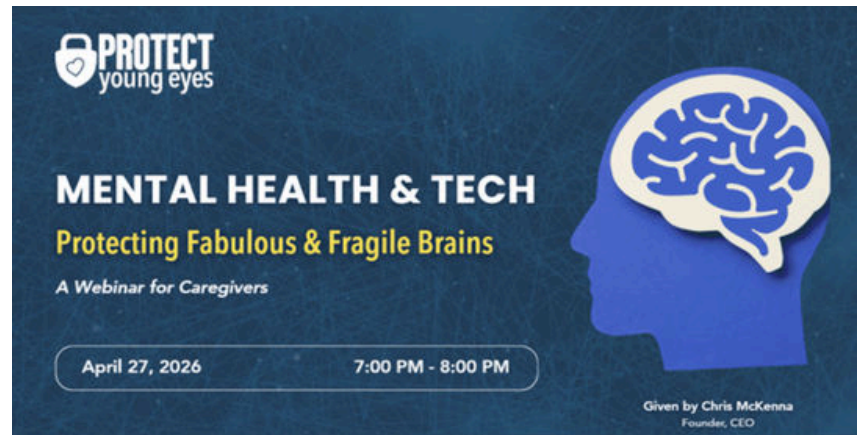
AISCA has teamed up with Protect Young Eyes to bring you a webinar on this evening at 7:00 PM, designed for parents and caring adults.

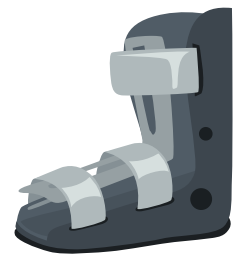
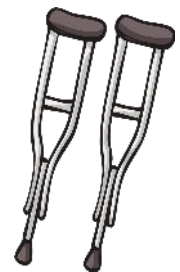


Equip the Comeback
