



## Dufour, DuPont, Vlooswyk Win WHL Championship

Congratulations to Mirco Dufour, Landon DuPont, and Luke Vlooswyk on capturing the Western Hockey League Championship with the Everett Silvertips – the first WHL title in Everett’s franchise history.

The Silvertips put together a dominant playoff run, posting a 16-1-1 record on their way to the championship before advancing to the Memorial Cup Final, where they fell to the Kitchener Rangers.

Landon was particularly outstanding throughout the postseason, recording 23 points (5 G, 18 A) in 18 WHL playoff contests before adding another six points (2 G, 4 A) at the Memorial Cup.

While the ultimate prize slipped away, all three Mountaineers contributed for the Silvertips this season. We are incredibly proud of Mirco, Landon, and Luke for helping bring a WHL championship to Everett and representing Edge School on one of junior hockey’s biggest stages.

# 10 Selected in WHL Draft



The 2026 WHL Prospects Draft took place on May 6 & 7, with 10 Mountaineers hearing their names called by Western Hockey League clubs.

- **Brody Antignani** was the first Mountaineer off the board, selected by the Spokane Chiefs (1st Round, 12th Overall) after two outstanding seasons in the CSSHL. In 81 combined regular season and playoff games with U15 and U15 Prep, Antignani recorded 187 points, including 92 goals and 95 assists. Brody signed with Spokane on June 9.
- **Keyn Lindberg** was drafted by the Red Deer Rebels (3rd Round, 48th Overall) following two strong seasons on the blue line with U15 and U15 Prep that saw him total 49 points in 75 combined games.
- **Luke Bodtker** earned selection by the Medicine Hat Tigers (3rd Round, 57th Overall) after compiling 109 points (44 G, 65 A) in 70 combined games across the regular season and playoffs with U15 and U15 Prep.
- **Zach Pomeroy** was picked by the Vancouver Giants (4th Round, 74th Overall) after producing 64 points in 66 combined CSSHL games.
- **Kai Genereaux** was selected by the Lethbridge Hurricanes (6th Round, 120th Overall) after posting 13 points in 32 combined games this season.
- **Lachlan Kisio** was drafted by the Brandon Wheat Kings (7th Round, 153rd Overall) after recording 51 points in 62 combined games.
- **Cade Mazurski** was selected by the Kamloops Blazers (7th Round, 158th Overall) after tallying 87 points in 73 combined games over his U15 and U15 Prep career.
- **Charlie Usher** was chosen by the Victoria Royals (8th Round, 166th Overall) after helping Edge's U15 team capture a CSSHL Championship last season. Usher registered 45 points in 40 combined CSSHL regular season and playoff games and is set to join the U17 Prep team next season.
- In goal, **Cohen Spencer** was drafted by the Portland Winterhawks (9th Round, 189th Overall) after backstopping the U15 Prep team to a CSSHL Western Championships finals appearance. Spencer earned 11 wins in 24 combined regular season and playoff games while posting a 2.76 goals-against average and .912 save percentage during the playoffs.
- **James Butterwick** was also selected by the Portland Winterhawks (9th Round, 194th Overall). Butterwick compiled 80 points in 76 combined games with U15 and U15 Prep.

Although the WHL Draft represents an exciting milestone, it is only one step in the hockey journey. Edge School is equally proud of the many student-athletes who were not selected this year but continue to demonstrate tremendous growth, character and potential. Development paths look different for every player, and we look forward to seeing all of our Mountaineers continue to pursue their goals and opportunities at the next level.

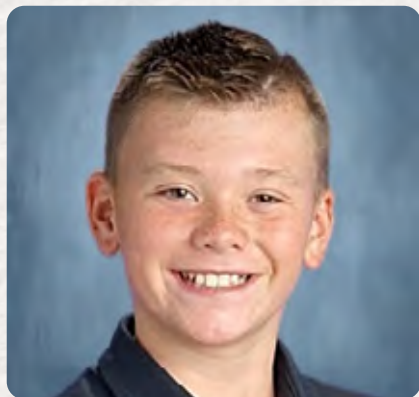
## Bleile Launches Chestermere Lake Cleanup Challenge

# Edge School Recognition Program

## Mountaineer Award

The Mountaineer Award is awarded to any student who has shown outstanding LEAD qualities and has consequently earned an overall average rubric score of 3.5 in all classes and sport blocks including LEAD class.

They must have all 3's and 4's to qualify and be registered in one core academic class in addition to PE and Leadership, Character and Social Responsibility.

## Highest Climbers

- Awarded at the end of Term 2 and 4 (in both academics and athletics). Honours students who have shown consistent effort, determination and a strong work ethic. This individual has overcome challenges, set high standards for themselves and inspired others with their dedication to growth.

## "High Five"

- These awards can be effort based, improvement based or performance based in any of our three spheres.
- Any staff can award a "High Five" via a Google Form nomination.
- Students can also nominate a classmate/teammate with their teacher or coach. The teacher/coach will award it if they deem it is warranted.
- Each month every "High Five" nomination will be entered into a draw for gift cards and prizes.

## Honour Roll

85% average in **all classes** with **no** mark below 80%

- Senior (Grade 10-12) must be taking minimum of 3 classes per semester that you are enrolled at Edge, **includes all classes** (except online classes). If the 3rd class is an online class, it qualifies the student for consideration for the award but the mark in the online class does not count toward the overall average.
- Junior (Grade 4-9) **includes all classes**

## Academic Excellence

90% average in **core** classes (English, Social Studies, Math, Sciences, Spanish) with no mark below 85%

- For senior (Grade 10-12) – must be taking minimum of 3 classes per semester that you are enrolled at Edge, **includes all classes** (except online classes). If the 3rd class is an online class, it qualifies the student for consideration for the award but the mark in the online class does not count toward the overall average.

## Top Academic Award

Top academic average in each grade in core classes (English, Social Studies, Math, Sciences, Spanish)

- For senior (Grade 10-12) – must be taking minimum of 3 classes per semester that you are enrolled at Edge, **includes all classes** (except online classes).
