Online Learning at Edge

Online learning offers flexibility for students with demanding schedules while maintaining the expectations and standards of a traditional course. Success in an online course requires strong time-management, organization, and communication skills.

Online Courses are delivered through partnership with **Golden Hills School Division**, which provides certified teachers and structured online programming through Moodle.

Registration

Online courses are available to Grade 11 and 12 students at Edge. However, courses that can be scheduled within the regular academic timetable cannot be moved to an online format.

Registration is completed by [filling out and submitting this form](#). Once registered, your course is delivered through **Moodle**, Golden Hills' online learning platform. Students will receive login information on their Edge school email account.

Course Expectations

Students are expected to:

- Check Moodle regularly.
- Stay on pace with the course timeline.
- Submit assignments by established deadlines.
- Review teacher feedback.
- Communicate with teachers when support is needed.

Students enrolled in Semester 2 courses must complete all coursework by the **second week of June**, in accordance with Golden Hills timelines. There are no extensions in June.

Assessments

Most courses include:

- A midterm exam
- A final exam

Exams may include written and multiple-choice components and can take up to **six hours** to complete. Students should plan ahead and set aside adequate time for these assessments.

Diploma Exams are registered and written at Edge.



Teacher and School Support

Each course is supported by a dedicated **Golden Hills teacher**, who is the student's first point of contact for questions related to coursework and assessments.

Students will also be scheduled into an **iLearn block at Edge**, where attendance and academic progress will be monitored. Additional support and communication with Golden Hills teachers can be facilitated as needed.

Costs

Students may take up to **10 online credits per school year** without additional cost.

Students taking **more than 10 online credits** will be billed at a rate of **\$157 per credit**.

Example:

- 15 credits = 5 billable credits = **\$785**

Invoices will be issued through Edge School.

Keys to Success

- ✓ **Follow the course timeline** and avoid falling behind.
- ✓ Check Moodle regularly.
- ✓ Read and apply teacher feedback.
- ✓ Communicate with teachers and ask for help when needed.
- ✓ **Use your iLearn block productively** and seek support early.

Online learning provides flexibility, but students who are proactive, engaged, and organized are the most successful.
