Proposed Multi-Sport Dome at Edge – Open House

Edge School is continuing to explore the development of a permanent, air-supported dome over our existing Stuart-Duckett artificial turf field, creating the opportunity for year-round sport and recreation use for both our students and the broader community.

Following a very positive response to our initial community engagement survey, our Board of Directors has approved moving forward with preliminary planning and design. Before submitting a formal Development Permit Application to Rocky View County, we want to ensure our families, neighbours and community members have an opportunity to learn more about the proposed project, ask questions and provide feedback.

We invite you to join us for a Dome Project Information Open House on Monday, September 21, in the Edge School Learning Commons.

The evening will provide an opportunity to learn more about the proposed dome, preliminary plans and the vision for transitioning the existing seasonal turf field into a year-round facility.
